# The Tournament

Google “golf club pro,” and you find this description: “An expert golfer who helps run a golf club and teaches others how to play the game. The specific duties of golf club professionals vary depending on the size and type of club where they work.”

To be sure, the time demands of such a job often preclude the pro from polishing his own game.

But some still find a way to enjoy success as a player while concurrently running their home club seamlessly.

Meet Dwayne Randall, in his third year as Bartlett Country Club’s pro.

He has represented the home course in the last two Southwestern New York-Northwestern Pennsylvania Men’s Amateur Tournaments and participants in the Southern Tier’s premier match-play event have unfailingly praised Randall’s efforts. They rave about the shape of the course, tee-offs being on time, decisive answers on rules questions and his total cooperation with tournament officials.

But what makes Randall different, besides his preoccupation with being the pro Bartlett members expect, is the extraordinary success he’s enjoyed as a player.

In May he was named Western New York PGA Player of the Decade (2010-19) after being tabbed WNY Player of the Year five times in those 10 years (2010-12, ’14 and ’18).

Since turning pro 25 years ago, Randall has won more than 110 tournaments and qualified for the PGA National Championship 12 times.

In an interview with the Times Herald’s J.P. Butler after earning the Player of the Decade citation, Randall allowed, “I’ve been fortunate as far as being able to play well in tournaments. It’s golf, you don’t always play well, but for whatever reason in tournaments I seem to do better. I don’t know why – maybe my focus narrows a little more than a casual round.”

But he quickly added, “As much as I love to play and represent the club, first and foremost my responsibilities at the club take precedence over anything. If there’s any kind of conflict, obviously, I don’t go somewhere to play in a tournament; I stay here and take care of the event we’re hosting. But if there are no conflicts, it’s something I look forward to.”

Randall, 48, has shot three career 59s, which speaks to his tournament success.

“I’m just one of those fortunate people that don’t need to practice a lot in order to stay sharp,” he said. “The best part of my game is putting, so I don’t really need to ever practice that, I just tend to make putts and obviously that always helps.”

Randall’s tournament play is divided between club-pro events and pro-ams.

“You always want to play well for your amateur partners because they’re competing and you’re part of their team,” he said of the latter, “you never want to let anybody down by not playing well.”
